Therefore Under the relevant G/O Rules I **GEETIKA SINGH, JUDICIAL MAGISTRATE (I), SHAHJAHNPUR** would like to declare.

a) That my visit to abroad in no way is likely to create any dilemma before the Government of India or before the Government of U.P.
