INTRODUCTION

THE UNIVERSITY

Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra established in 1957, has a well-developed multi-faculty Campus spread over 473 acres of land. Ever since laying of foundation stone by Dr. Rajendra Prasad, the First President of India, the University has taken quantum leaps and has emerged as an advanced centre of Study & Research for quality education in conformity with the international standards.
