10. *That, the applicant had never applied for No Objection Certificate/Identity Certificate for the same before this, therefore, no request of applicant was ever refused.*
11. *That, the applicant never visited any foreign country earlier;*
12. *List of dependents of applicant-*
 - A. *Smt. Urvashi (wife) Age about 55 years*
 - B. *Ravi Bhusan (Son) Age about 25 years.*

It is, therefore most humbly requested that, my request for grant of No Objection Certificate/Identity Certificate may kindly be placed before the Hon'ble High Court for its kind consideration.


