Undertaking

- 1- Harshita, Civil Judge (J.D.)/FTC/ (Crime Against Women), Hamirpur declared as under-
- (a) That the applicant is a citizen of India.
- (b) That the applicant may not, or in not likely to, engage outside India in activities prejudicial to the sovereignty and integrity of India.
- (c) That the departure of the applicant from India may not, or is not likely to be detrimental to the security of India.
- (d) That the presence of the applicant outside India may not, or is not likely to prejudice the friendly relations of India with any foreign country.
- **(e)** That the applicant has, at any time during the period of 5 years immediately preeceding the date of her application, not beeen convicted by a court in India for any offence involving moral turpitude and sentenced in respect thereof to imprisonment for not less than two years.
- (f) That proceedings in respect of any offence alleged to have been committed by the applicant are not pending before a criminal court of India.
- (g) That a warrant or summons for the appearance or a warrant for the arrest, of the applicant has not been issued by a court under any law for the time being in force or that an order prohibiting the departure from India of the applicant has not been made by any such court.
- **(h)** That the applicant has not been repatriated.
- (i) That there is no possibility of arising embarrassing position before government of UP. due to my visit to any foreign country.
- (j) That "a passport was never refused to me for the issue of identity certificate."
