He has further stated that he wants to take admission in the academic session from July 2020- July 2022, and he would not take study leave for the said Course. He has also enclosed letter of the University regarding UGC recognition and copy of notification regarding the non requirement of attending day to day classes as attachments. He has, therefore, requested for grant of permission to do/ pursue LL.M. Course through distance education programme from Kurukshetra University. In this connection, it is stated that Sri Manoj has joined the U.P. Nyayik Sewa on 01.01.2020. There is circular letter dated 4.11.11, which provides that if any Judicial Officer during the course of his Service, requests to pursue higher studies, he has to apply for grant of 'Study Leave' as per rules which will be subject to the discretion of Hon'ble the Chief Justice. In the instant case, the officer has stated that he would not take study leave for the said LL.M. Course, his request appears to be considerable.
