Subject:- Grant of Permission/ Issuance of 'Identity Certificate' to Sri Chandra Mohan Mishra, Spl. Judge (E.C. Act), Pilibhit for obtaining Passport..

Sir,

With reference to your endt. no. 1679/l-2022 dated 01.09.2022, on the above subject, I have to say that Sri Chandra Mohan Mishra, Spl. Judge (E.C. Act), Pilibhit may kindly be informed that for obtaining passport, permission is not granted by the Hon'ble Court but 'Identity Certificate' as prescribed by the Passport office is issued by the Hon'ble Court on such request. However, for issuance of 'Identity Certificate' to obtain passport, the officer has to submit his fresh online application through e-services portal only as per direction of the Hon'ble Court's letter no. 558/XXXIII-CPC/e-Courts/ Allahabad/ Dated: 31 August 2019 alongwith following information/ declarations as per Section 6 (2) of the Passports Act, 1967 on an 'Affidavit' and affidavit should also be sent in original, offline mode separately as well as names of his dependent family members, as on date, which was earlier intimated to all the judicial officer through an e-mail vide Court's letter no. 16044/ Ivf-101/ Admin (A)/ Dated 24.11.2015:-

- (a) that the applicant is a citizen of India;
- (b) that the applicant may not, or is not likely to, engage outside India in activities prejudicial to the sovereignty and integrity of India;
- (c) that the departure of the applicant from India may not, or is not likely to, be detrimental to the security of India;
- (d) that the presence of the applicant outside India may not, or is not likely to, prejudice the friendly relations of India with any foreign country;
- (e) that the applicant has, at any time during the period of five years immediately preceding the date of his application, not being convicted by a court in India for any offence involving moral turpitude and sentenced in respect thereof to imprisonment for not less than two years;
- (f) that proceedings in respect of any offence alleged to have not been committed by the applicant are pending before a criminal court in India;
- (g) that a warrant or summons for the appearance, or a warrant for the arrest, of the applicant has not been issued by a court under any law for the time being

in force or that an order prohibiting the departure from India of the applicant has not been made by any such court;

- (h) that the applicant has not been repatriated.
- (I) Whether there is any possibility of arising embarrassing position before Government of U.P. due to his visit to any foreign country?
- (J) Whether issue of 'Identity Certificate' for obtaining a passport was ever refused to him?
- (k) Whether he has visited any foreign country earlier and, if so, intimate details of the same,

Sri Chandra Mohan Mishra may kindly be requested to submit all the required details alongwith four photographs of himself (in hard copy also, separately as the photographs have to be pasted on 'Identity Certificate'), out of which one should be attested/certified by you, at the earliest, so that further necessary action regarding issuance of 'Identity Certificate', for obtaining Passport may be taken.
