

4. That the presence of the deponent outside India may not, or is not likely to, prejudice the friendly relations of India with any foreign country;
5. That the deponent has, at any time during the period of five years immediately preceding the date of his application, not being convicted by a court in India for any offence involving moral turpitude and sentenced in respect thereof to imprisonment for not less than two years;
6. That proceedings in respect of any offence alleged to have not been committed by the deponent are pending before a criminal court in India.
7. That a warrant or summons for the appearance, or a warrant for the arrest, of the deponent has not been issued by a court under any law for the time being in force or that an order prohibiting the departure from India of the deponent has not been made by any such court;
8. That the deponent has not been repatriated;
9. That, there is no possibility of arising embarrassing position before Government of U.P. due to deponent's visit to any foreign country.
10. That, issue of 'Identity Certificate' for obtaining a passport was never refused to the deponent.
11. That, deponent has never visited any foreign country earlier.
