Subject: Wrong Feeding of data in CIS.

Sir/Madam,

This is to inform that frequent complaints of the litigants are being forwarded by the e-Committee, Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, highlighting that wrong feeding of dates in cases is being done by the different Courts of Uttar Pradesh. Further, repeated complaints of such nature are also being regularly received by Hon'ble High Court from the litigants with respect to wrong feeding of case dates in CIS.

In this regard, Hon'ble Court has observed that inspite of several directions issued from time to time to the District Courts, it is being regularly reported that, the dates fixed in Case files and the dates fed in CIS are different. Such act of wrong feeding of data appears to be deliberate and it is not only affecting data history of cases in CIS but is also misleading the different Stake holders, using the web based eCourts Services & eCourts App. The entire exercise of Computerization of Cases is becoming futile. It was further observed that the matter is serious and the same comes under the definition of misconduct.



Accordingly, Hon'ble Court has been pleased to approve as follows:-

- All the District Judges of Uttar Pradesh must ensure that the Presiding Officers of the Courts cross verify the Reader's Diary with CIS generated cause list on daily basis to check discrepancies and ensure that dates in cases are updated timely & accurately in the CIS.
- 2. A certificate in this regard be given by all the Presiding Officers to the District Judge with respect to accuracy of data on fortnightly basis.
- 3. A consolidated report of above certification be placed by Office of CPC, before Chairperson, Computerization Committee(eCP).
- 4. The District Judges may inform all the Presiding Officers and staff of the Courts that cases of wrong data feeding, mismatch between actual date fixed in records and the date fed in CIS or any other irregularity in data uploading/ updating, coming to light after 01st June 2019, shall attract suitable disciplinary action against the concerned Court Staff.
- 5. The District Judge shall take necessary assistance of Nodal Officers & System Officers/ System Assistants for monitoring the daily forwarding of data of each Court, including bulk data forwarding and for reporting discrepancies to him, on a daily or weekly basis.

In view of above, I request your goodself to direct the concerned Judicial Officers /Court Staffs to ensure the strict compliance accordingly.
