The Directorate is also providing two year B.Ed. programme with the approval of NCTE for the benefit of working teachers in schools and other educational institutions.

The Directorate has a separate three-storey teaching-block exclusively for the distance education students. It houses well-equipped, centrally air-conditioned Computer Labs and Library, lecture halls, commonrooms, teacher-rooms, etc.
