Respected Sir,

Most respectfully, I hereby beg to state that I want to apply for Indian Passport as some of my close relatives and friends reside in foreign Countries. In near future, there is possibility of visiting them with kind prior permission of the Hon'ble High Court. For that I need to have a passport. 3. Prior to this application, I have never applied for issue of "**No Objection Certificate**" for obtaining Passport; as such, there has been no occasion for its rejection.
4. I have never visited any foreign country since I do not possess a passport and had never applied before for obtaining the same.

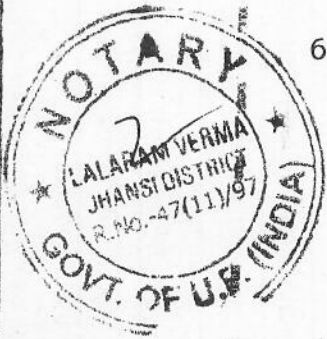
Affidavit in the matter of:- Issuance of Identity Certificate for obtaining
