I am directed to quote the extract of decisions of the meeting of the Directors, Dear's members of Advisory Committee and Senior Officers of the University to finalize conduct of terminal semester examination in the light of UGC Guidelines dated 08/07/2020 held on 04/08/2020 under the Chairmanship of the Vice-Chancellor.

It was also decided that sessionals for terminal and intermediate year students should be over by 25th August 2020. The end-semester examinations in online OBE system may be scheduled during 10<sup>th</sup> -25<sup>th</sup> September 2020.

The Vice-Chancellor requested the Deans of the Faculties to ensure that resource material/teaching notes of the entire semester (including the period when teaching was conducted in face-to-face/regular mode prior to closure of the University on 08/03/2020) for the students of terminal semester be uploaded/provided to the students within two weeks.

The above is notified to all concerned for necessary action accordingly.

In view of the current COVID-19 pandemic situation and considering inconvenience to the students, the Executive Council of the University has approved amendment for the conduct of various examinations of the University.

In this backdrop the attention of the students of LL.B. 3 year course (VI Semester), LL.B. 5 year course (X Semester), LL.M. (General and HRDE course, IV Semester) and LL.M One Year course (II Semester), session 2019-20, is hereby drawn to comply with the requirement of submitting assignments as instructed by the respective concerned subject teachers vide their Email registered with the University. Students should note that this assignment carries total 30 marks. In case of any difficulty, students should consult the respective subject teachers.

Students of LL.M. Courses have to submit their dissertation online to their concerned supervisors.

All the aforesaid students are advised to submit the assignment latest by 25<sup>th</sup> August 2020 so that the evaluation should be done in time.

NOTIFICATION

I am directed to notify the following recommendations of the Academic Council (ACR No.1 dated 27.07.2020), duly approved by the Executive Council (Plan No.1 ECR No.107 dated 31.07.2020):

1. "Seminars for the students of intermediate semester/terminal semester during academic session 2019-20"
  - (i) Different components of seminars may be scheduled by "Assignment" based assessment.
  - (ii) The students may be given assignment by 31<sup>st</sup> July 2020 with a time frame of fifteen days for its completion. The assignment may be given by the teacher concerned to the students of higher class over email. The students can submit the assignment to the concerned teacher over email. After evaluation for 20 marks, the marks of seminars would be uploaded by the teacher concerned on the portal labeled by 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2020. To bring in uniformity in standards of "Assignment" across different courses run by a Faculty and within a course (which is taught by different teachers in different batches/courses), prior discussion at the Faculty/Department level needs to be done.
  - (iii) In such courses where seminars have been held or partly completed before the University closed in middle of March 2020, students may be given the option of opting for "Assignment" based seminars as alternate. In case they opt "Assignment" based seminars, marks obtained by them in previously held seminars may be compared with the marks obtained by them in "Assignment" based seminars and the better of the two may be taken. This will bring in uniformity.
  - (iv) The distribution of weightage of pre- and end semester examinations for the students of 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> semester shall be 30:70. Keeping in view the UGC Guidelines, dated 29.04.2020 and 08.07.2020, the distribution of weightage of individual and end semester examination for students of intermediate semesters be kept at 50:50.

2. Promotion of students of Intermediate semesters (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Semester) of academic session 2019-20 to higher semesters (5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Semester, respectively) of 2020-21.

- (i) In relation of the provisions of existing Ordinances of the courses on necessity of obtaining 4.0 CGPA for promotion to higher year of the course, students of intermediate semesters of academic session 2019-20 would be promoted to higher semesters during the academic session 2020-21.
  - (ii) For the students of Intermediate semesters of academic session 2019-20, no end semester examinations would be conducted. Their grade sheet for the 2<sup>nd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> semester, as the case may be, shall be prepared in the following manner:
    - a) Marks against the semester component of 80 marks would be based on evaluation of "Assignment", as mentioned above.
    - b) Marks against end semester component of 20 marks would be based on the performance of the student in the preceding semester. For example, if CGPA of a student for 4<sup>th</sup> semester during 2019-20 is 3<sup>rd</sup> semester was 8.21, higher percentage of marks using the conversion formula % of marks = 1/3 x CGPA - 4.5 becomes 77.50% which can be equated to 16 marks.
  - (iii) In case a student is not satisfied by the marks obtained by teacher in the even semester component of academic session 2019-20, desired to the concerned teacher, teacher may improve the grade by appearing in the next makeable examination of such courses in succeeding academic semester.
  - (iv) The students of the intermediate semesters having backlog of earlier semester will be required to clear the examination of the course in which backlog has been/has been declared, whenever the examination is held next.
- Accordingly, relevant provisions of the Ordinances governing concerned courses stand amended to the aforesaid extent with immediate effect with applicability of the Ordinances, so amended, for the students of even semester of academic session 2019-20 only.

All the concerned are requested to take immediate necessary action accordingly.
