Sub: Intimation regarding pursuing L.L.M.

Respected Sir,

It is most humbly submitted vide notification no. 3940 dated 14.11.2019, that I, Shefali Yadav had joined and taken charge Additional Civil Judge (J.D) Court NO.3, Meerut, on 16.11.2019. It is pertinent to mention here that, before the joining the judicial service, I had taken admission in the three years regular L.L.M regular course (Evening Batch) of 2017 from University of Delhi. This is my final Semester VI and I'll have to submit my dissertation along with that, I'll also have to take a few of my pending Semester examination. It must be noted that I fulfilled all the eligibility requirements which is needed to sit for the examination. When I took charge as additional Civil Judge I was in the V Semester of L.L.M. I have 66.66% attendance until V Semester that is prior to my joining as the Additional Civil Judge. I made sure that I have requisite attendance in all my Semesters. 66.6 % attendance in my V Semester entitles me to sit for the exam. In VI Semester I'm only required to submit dissertation there are no classes being taken for the VI Semester. Therefore, I wouldn't be requiring any additional attendance. These are the following examination for which I repeat, no additional attendance is required on my behalf.

1. Administrative Law subject of First Semester. This is a supplementary paper and wouldn't require any additional attendance.
2. Environmental Law Subject of III Semester. This is also a supplementary paper and wouldn't require any additional attendance.
3. Corporate Finance Subject of IV Semester: An open book online examination was held for this subject. On August 19, 1920. But since I didn't seek permission from the Hon'ble Court I could not sit for the examination. The examination for this particular subject will again be held on May 2021 and I request permission for the same.
4. Corporate Management and social responsibility and Law of the Sea Subjects of V Semester: The V Semester examination were held in December 2019. But since, I didn't seek permission from the Hon'ble Court I couldn't sit for the examination.

The first, third and fifth Semester examination will now be held in December 2020. And I seek the permission from the Hon'ble Court to sit for the same.

5. For the dissertation it is necessary to meet the guide and I have had a word with my mentor and she had readily agreed to corporate with me and guide me over telephonic call for my dissertation.

Further, it is respectfully, submitted that my pursuing of L.L.M course would not adversely hamper in discharge of my official duty. It would rather enhance my judicial aptitude and acumen which would help in discharging my official duties and for the same would require permission from the Hon'ble Court is desired.
