Dear Candidates,

A. This is with reference to your application for registration to the Ph.D. Course in Faculty of Law.

You are hereby informed that the Departmental Research Committee in Law at its meeting held on 10,11 and 12 October 2018 decided to provisionally register you for the above course in the area of tentative Ph.D./Research as follows:

Name of Student : Namrata Singh

Tentative Title : Reproductive rights of woman with disabilities: Indian and International perspectives.

Name of Supervisor : Prof. Ved Kumari
Co-Supervisor : Dr. Awakta Verma

B. The admission and Continuation of Ph.D. is regulated by ordinance VI dated 9 August, 2017 and the scholar accepts its terms and conditions by submission of fee available on DU website link.

C. Course Work

1. As per the current Ordinance VI every scholar shall undertake course work for a year consisting of three courses as approved by the Departmental Research Committee (DRC) & Board of Research Studies (BRS) in law. The Course work has been notified on Law Faculty Website.
2. The credits of the coursework shall be transferable between the Departments of the University and interuniversity, subject to their acceptance by the Departmental Research Committee.
3. The Ph.D. scholar has to obtain a minimum of 55% of marks in the course work in order to be eligible to continue in the programme.
4. The DRC shall satisfy itself that each research scholar has completed the requirement of coursework. The Head of the Department shall provide to the students a certificate of completion of coursework and names of courses completed by each student. If a research scholar fails to qualify the coursework, he/she may be allowed to reappear only once within six months of the declaration of result. If the result is still found unsatisfactory, DRC may recommend cancellation of his/her registration. This may be reported to the Board of Research Studies. Under special circumstances (e.g. medical reasons) a final decision may be taken by BRS on the recommendation of the DRC. It is clear from above that immediately after joining Ph.D. you have to undertake the course work and only on successful completion of the same you would continue with your Ph.D otherwise your admission stand cancelled.

D. Attendance:

Research scholars shall be required to attend lectures (coursework) and participate in seminars arranged in the Department during the programme. The minimum percentage of lectures to be attended during the coursework will be two-thirds of the lectures delivered in all courses individually. "Seminars" include pre submission seminars, six monthly 'Research-in-Progress' seminars, as well as open viva-voce seminars presented by other research scholars in addition to seminars given by invited experts.

E. Procedure for admission:

1. The research scholar shall not be allowed to take up any assignment outside the University during the course work.
2. No research scholar registered for the Ph.D. programme shall be permitted to undertake any other full time programme during the pendency of the Ph.D. programme.

F. Fellowship

Non-net fellowship is available to non-JRF scholars admitted to the Ph.D. programme as per the availability.

- G. The fee is to be paid online on the university website with the link: (<http://www.finance.du.ac.in/>)

You are required to contact Mr. Pant in the Dean's office of the Faculty of Law along with an affidavit for not engaging in any gainful activity for a period of one year outside the University during the course work along with all certificates/testimonials (in Original) in support of educational qualifications etc. before depositing the fee.

The effective date of registration would be the date of depositing the requisite fee, after completion of all formalities. You are advised to complete all the formalities within one week from the date of issue of this letter. A joining report, duly forwarded by supervisor named herein is required for completing the Ph.D. admission formalities.

- H. Ph.D is not permitted in a distance education mode. You are advised to be in constant touch with your Supervisor and meet him/her at least thrice a week.

However, after the completion of the one year course work you may be permitted to do part time Ph.D. with due permission of the DRC on the recommendation of your supervisor provided all the conditions mentioned in the extant Ordinance VI of Delhi University are met.

You are required to give 'research in progress' seminar every six months after completion of your course work. A written report of your progress needs to be submitted to the Dean with the comments of the members of the Research one of whom must be from within the Law Faculty, Delhi University. Failing to fulfill the above requirements may result in deletion of your name from the rolls of Ph.D. Scholars.
