
Respectfully I have to state that I want to apply for renewal of an ordinary Indian Passport for which I am in need of 'NOC' (as annexure-G) being a Government employee.

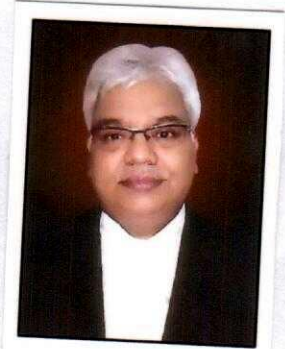
