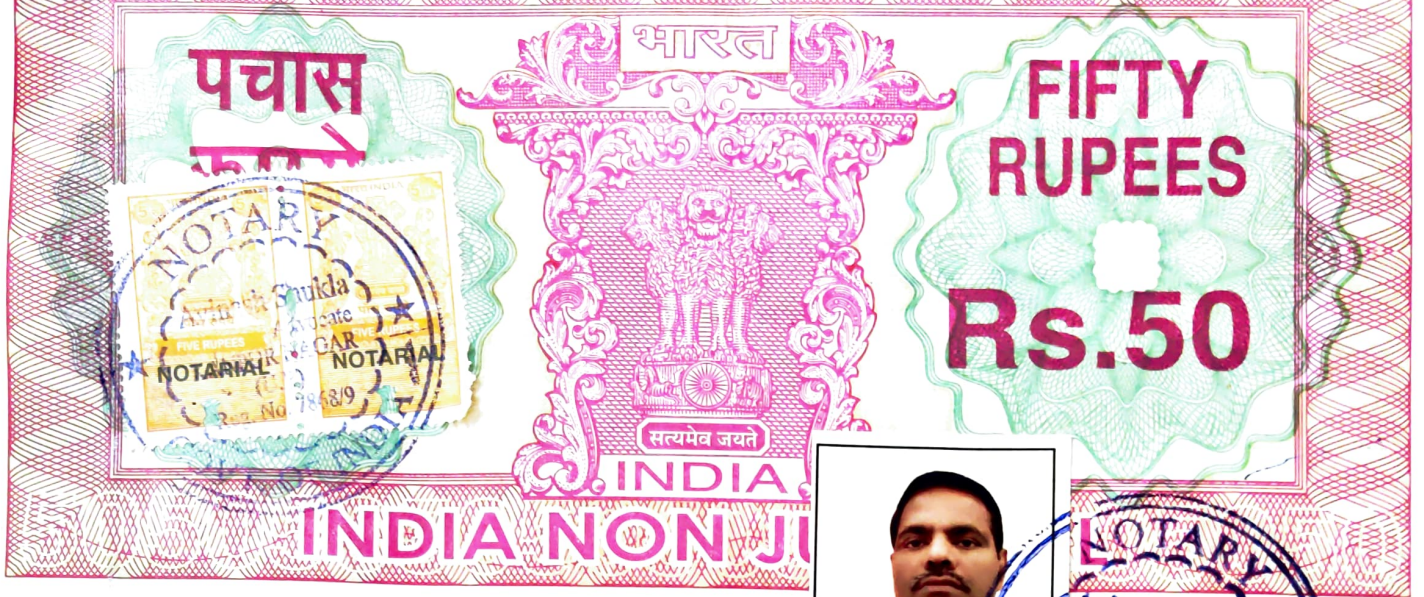

- h) that the applicant has not been repatriated;
- i) that there is no possibility of arising embarrassing position before Government of U.P. due to his visit to any foreign country.
- j) that issue of 'Identity Certificate' for obtaining a passport was never refused to him.
- k) that he has not visited any foreign country earlier.

I hereby state that whatever is stated hereinabove is true to the best of my knowledge.
