Q. What is the exam pattern for PhD Admission entrance test?

The Entrance test will have 70 MCQ to evaluate knowledge in core subject (50) and research aptitude (20) for a total of 70 marks; Entrance test will be followed by interview for 30 marks. Candidates with valid selection from NET / GATE / SET / UET / any other equivalent test conducted GOI accredited agency (to be decided by the selection committee) are exempted from entrance test and get preference in selection. M.Phil. degree holders from UGC accredited universities are also exempted from entrance test.

Q. What is the intake capacity for the PhD programme?

The number of seats in different schools may increase or decrease depending on the availability of eligible supervisors.

Q. What would be the curriculum for my PhD programme?

Syllabi of the core subjects are of PG level in respective disciplines / subjects. There will common entrance test for subjects common to different schools (e.g. Microbiology, Biotechnology etc.) but different panels will conduct interviews depending on the eligibility and aptitude of the candidates.

Q. Does Sharda University offer part-time PhD programmes?

Yes, Sharda University offers various part-time doctoral programmes in multiple fields like engineering, architecture, management, law, pharmacy, basic sciences etc.

Q. Is there any stipend offered for fellowship?

Fellowship for Full time PhD Scholar: For NET/GATE (valid score) qualified: Rs.25,000/-, Rs.25000/- and Rs.27,000/- for 1st, 2nd and 3rd year respectively whereas for non-NET/GATE qualified: Rs.18,000/-, Rs. 19,000/- and Rs. 20,000/- respectively. Fellowships are subject to conditions given in the notifications.

## Q. Can I pursue PhD with my job?

Yes, Sharda University offers various PhD part time programmes in multiple fields for those individuals who want to pursue their doctoral degree while still working.

## Q. Is there a provision for scholarships?

Yes. Fellowship for Full time PhD Scholar: For NET/GATE (valid score) qualified: Rs.25,000/-, Rs.25000/- and Rs.27,000/- for 1st, 2nd and 3rd year respectively whereas for non-NET/GATE qualified: Rs.18,000/-, Rs. 19,000/- and Rs. 20,000/- respectively.
