IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES

Candidates are advised to follow the instructions given below carefully :-

1. Candidates shall produce their Hall Ticket at the Entrance of the Examination Centre and also in the Examination Hall/Room, failing which the candidates will not be allowed to write the examination. The candidates shall sign the attendance sheet in the Examination Hall.

- 2. Candidates will not be permitted to enter into the examination hall after 9.00 a.m. for Paper I and Paper III. For Paper II candidates will not be permitted to enter into the examination hall after 2.00 p.m.
- 3. Candidates shall not be allowed to leave the examination hall before 12:00 noon for Paper I and Paper III. For Paper II, the candidates shall not be allowed to leave the examination hall before 05:00 p.m.
- 4. Candidate have to write the hall ticket number in answer booklet for each session of the examination i.e. Paper-I, Paper-II and Paper-III provided to the more else the same will not be evaluated
- 5. Answer Sheets will not be valued if the candidates write any irrelevant matter, symbols, religious marks or identification marks on any part of Answer sheets or the Question paper, as it amounts to malpractice.
- 6. Candidates have to write the Question Number in the left margin of the answer papers, other wise the answer written will not be evaluated **Example:-**

7. Candidates are prohibited from communicating, consulting or conversing with other candidates in the examination hall or causing disturbance an any manner whatsoever.

8. No T.A. and D.A. will be paid for attending the examination.

- 9. Candidates will be permitted to appear for the examination after their credentials or verified by the centre officials and after frisking to ensure that no prohibited articles are carried. (Purses, and hand bags are also not allowed). At the Examination centre, the Authority will not make any arrangement for safe custody of any articles/things carried by the candidates and they shall make their own arrangements.
- 10. Candidates are not allowed to bring any Electronic devices such as Mobile/Cell phones, programmable calculators, Tablets, I-pad, Bluetooth, Pagers or any other device capable of interacting / programming to the examination centre. Any violation of the above leads to disqualification of the candidature.
- 11. The Hall Ticket must be presented for verification along with atleast one original valid identification card i.e. Advocate Identify Card, Pass Port, Pan Card, Voter ID, Aadhar Card, Govt. Employee ID or Driving Licence etc.,
- 12. Candidates will be allowed into the examination centre from 08:00 AM onwards for Paper-I and Paper-III on 08.01.2022 and 09.01.2022 and from 1.00 p.m. for paper-II on 08.01.2022 as the candidate have to undergo Biometric verification.
- 13. The check-in procedure in the examination hall includes Biometric Verification. This is a security feature which will allow authority to cross check the identify and also to prevent impersonation cases. Therefore, they are advised not to apply mehandi, ink etc on their Hands/Feet. In case if the Biometric machine is not supported to obtain the impression due to technical reasons in the beginning of examination, it would be taken at the end of examination.
- 14. Candidates will be permitted to occupy their allotted seats as and when they completed the Biometric Verification procedure before the scheduled start of the Examination. After the completion of the Biometric Verification, no candidate is allowed to leave the allotted Room/Hall.
- 15. Candidates are expected to behave in orderly and disciplined manner while taking the examination. The candidature will be rejected in case of impersonation/ disorder/ rowdy behavior during examination. Necessary FIR for the incident will be lodged with concerned Police Station apart from disqualifying the candidature. The centre Chief Invigilator is duly authorized to take spot action in such cases.
- 16. Frequent visits to toilet are not permitted. Candidates advised to use the toilet facility only in case of extreme necessity. If any candidate is found to be indulged in discussions or malpractice near the toilets or corridors of any other places, they would be disqualified.
- 17. Violation of any of the instructions may lead to invalidation of candidature besides penal action.
- 18. The candidate must follow Covid-19 guidelines like social distancing, wearing mask, using visible sanitizer etc.

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
