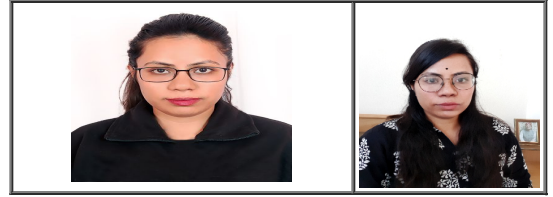

- Admit Card and/or ID on mobile phone will not be treated as a valid Admit Card/ID Proof and such candidates would not be permitted to enter the Delhi High Court premises.**
- You will be allowed 15 minutes reading time i.e. from 8.45 AM to 9.00 AM and from 02.15 P.M. to 02.30 P.M. on 11.06.2022 AND from 8.45 AM to 9.00 AM and from 2.15 PM to 2.30 PM on 12.06.2022, before the examination begins, during which you should read the question paper and, if you wish, highlight and/or make notes on the question paper. However, you will not be allowed, under any circumstances, to open the answer book and start writing during this reading time.

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES

1. The candidate must report at the designated Entry Gate of the Examination Centre at the Reporting Time mentioned in the Admit Card.
2. **IRIS verification of the candidate would be done in each session of the Examination. As such, the candidate must adhere to the Reporting Schedule as mentioned in the Admit Card to avoid delay in entry in the Examination Hall.**
3. Candidates must not wear contact lenses at the time of verification of identity during IRIS.
4. Candidate must wear a suitable/standard mask to cover his/her nose and mouth properly before entering the Examination Centre and keep it on until he/she remains in the Examination Centre. However, candidates will have to remove the mask for identification purpose.
5. No candidate shall be admitted to the Examination Hall after the distribution of the Question Paper nor shall any candidate be permitted to leave the Examination Hall until half of the time has elapsed after the commencement of the paper nor during the last 15 minutes of the allotted time.
6. The candidate should bring his/her own pen but not any other articles such as notes, loose sheets etc. in the Examination Hall.
7. The candidate must write in his/her own hand. Answers must NOT be written in pencil.
8. The candidate must not write any irrelevant matter i.e. anything other than the actual answers to questions inside his/her answer sheet.
9. Candidate is banned from writing his/her name, roll no. or any other identification mark on the answer sheet except on the cover page.
10. The candidate must attempt questions in accordance with the directions on each question paper.
11. No candidate shall copy from the papers of any other candidate, nor permit his/her own papers to be copied/nor give/nor attempt to give/nor obtain/nor attempt to obtain assistance of any description.
12. **The candidate is required to remain in his/her respective seat till the collection of his/her answer sheets by the Invigilator.**
13. After the examination is over, the candidate shall hand over the answer sheets to the invigilator.
14. After the examination is over, the candidate is allowed to take the question paper.
15. Silence must be observed in the Examination Hall.
16. Smoking in the Examination Hall is strictly prohibited.
17. You are allowed to bring your own water and sanitizer, essentially in transparent bottle only.
18. **Please note that the items listed below are strictly NOT allowed inside the examination centre campus:**
 - o **Mobile/Cell Phone, Bluetooth/wireless earphones/devices, Watch of any kind including digital/smart watch, bag, Handbag, papers, notes, books, calculator, car keys, electronic gadgets/equipments, correction marker/white fluid, any other suspicious item/material etc.**
 - o **It is clarified that there shall be no arrangements at Examination Centre for keeping aforesaid items. If any item is lost, the Centre or this Court will not be responsible for the same. Candidates are, therefore, advised either not to carry the aforementioned items with them on the date of the examination or to make their own arrangements for keeping such items in safe custody outside the Examination Centre at their own risk.**
19. Possessing any electronic device such as mobile phone/watch of any kind or any electronic equipment by the candidate inside the examination center campus before completion of the examination will be considered as attempting to take or send the Question Booklet in full or in part outside the examination room. Appropriate civil and/or criminal proceedings will be initiated against any such candidate taking or attempting to take or send the Question Booklet in full or in part outside the examination room besides cancellation of his/her candidature.
20. Such candidates who belong to Persons with Disabilities Category and have opted for Compensatory Time without scribe/with scribe shall be given 60 minutes Compensatory Time in addition to the prescribed time subject to furnishing of the Certificate of Limitation in writing in the prescribed format (if not already furnished) and the Affidavit.
21. Any candidate found using or in possession of such unauthorized material or indulging in copying or adopting unfair means would be liable to be summarily disqualified and shall be debarred from the future examinations in accordance with Clause D-5 of the Appendix to Delhi Judicial Service Rules - 1970.
22. Travelling and other expenses would be borne by the candidate himself/herself.
23. Any attempt to influence will lead to disqualification of candidature.
