



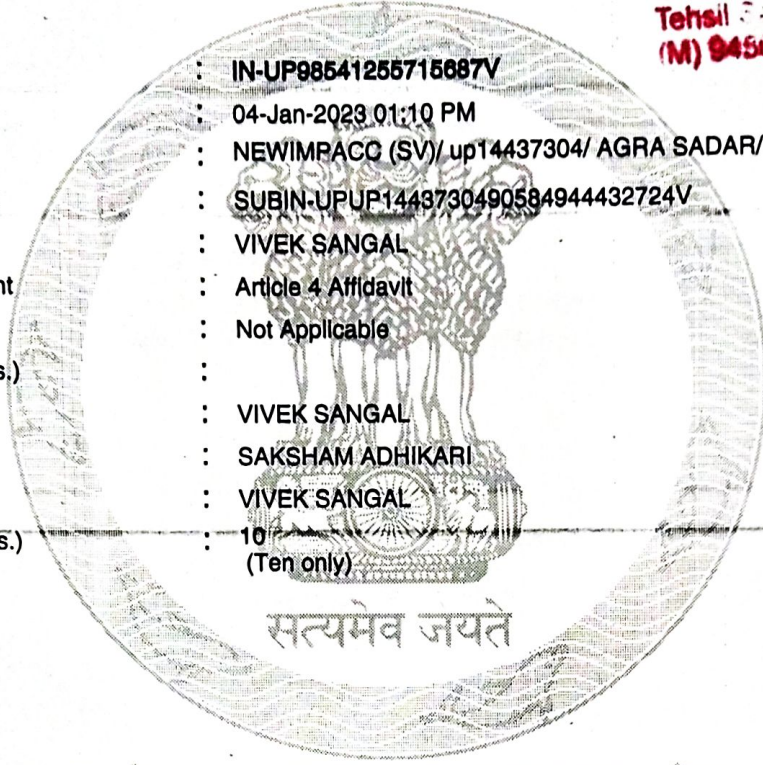

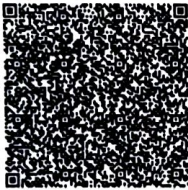

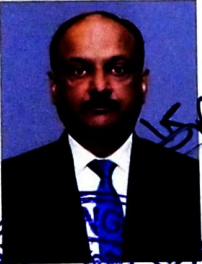

- (g) That a warrant or summons for the appearance or a warrant for the arrest of the applicant has not been issued by a Court under any law for the time being in force or that an order prohibiting the departure of applicant from India has not been made by any such Court.
- (h) That the applicant has not been repatriated.
- (i) That in the opinion of the Central Government the issue of a passport or travel document to the applicant will be in the public interest.
- (j) That there is no possibility of arising any embarrassing position before the Hon'ble High Court, the entire Judicial institution, the Government of India or the Government of U.P. due to applicant's visit to any foreign country.
- (k) That during any future foreign visit, the applicant will not indulge in any such activity that may adversely affect the international relations of that other country with the Republic of India or tends to tarnish the image of the Hon'ble High Court, the entire Judicial institution, the Government of India or the Government of U.P..
- (l) That previously Passport no. L9825970 was issued in the name of the applicant on the basis of the Identity Certificate issued by
