## UNDERTAKING

1- Rajat Singh Yadav, Civil Judge (J.D.)/Judicial Magistrate First Class Maudaha,

Hamirpur declared as under-

(A)- That the applicant is a citizen of India.

**(B)-** That the applicant may not, or is not likely to, engage outside india in activities prejudicial to the sovereignty and integrity of india.

**(C)-** That the departure of the applicant outside india may not, or is not likely to, be detrimental to the security of India.

**(D)-** That the presence of the applicant outside India may not, or is not likely to, Prejudice the friendly relations of India with any foreign country.

**(E)-** That the applicant has, at any time during the period of five years immediately preceding the date of his application, not being convicted by a court in India for any offence involving moral turpitude and sentenced in respect thereof to imprisonment for not less than two years.

**(F)-** That No proceedings in respect of any offence alleged to have not been committed by the applicant are pending before a criminal court in India.

**(G)-** That No warrant or summons for the appearance, or a warrant for the arrest, of the applicant has been issued by a court under any law for the time being in force or that an order prohibiting the departure from India of the applicant has not been made by any such court.

**(H)**- That the applicant has not been repatriated.

(I)- That there is no possibility of arising any embarrasing position before Government of U.P. due to his visit to any foreign country.

**(J)-** That No 'Identity Certificate' for obtaining a passport was ever refused to the applicant, as he has never applied for a passport before.

**(K)**- That the applicant has never visited any foreign country earlier.
