Subject: Regarding issue of "No Objection Certificate" for obtaining Indian
Passport.

Respected Sir,

Most respectfully, I hereby beg to state that I wish to go for pilgrimage to holy Mansarovar in future. With kind prior permission from Hon'ble High Court. For that I need to have a passport. For obtaining a passport from Govt. of India a "No Objection Certificate" issued by Hon'ble High Court is required.

Further, in compliance of Hon'ble High Court's Circular Letter No. 1349/IV-f-101/Admin. Dt 14.09.2006, I respectfully submit that:

- 1- There is no possibility of arising any embarrassing position before the Hon'ble High court, the entire Judicial institution, the Government of India or the Government of U.P. due to my proposed visit of Mansarovar.
- 2- During such proposed visit, I will not indulge in any such activity that may adversely affect the international relations of that other country with the Republic of India or tends to tarnish the image of the Hon'ble High court, the entire judicial institution, the Government of India or the Government of U.P.
- 3- Prior to this application, I have never applied for issuance of "No Objection Certificate" for obtaing Passport; as such, there has been no occasion for its rejection.
- 4- I have never visited any foreign country since I do not posses a passport and had never applied before for obtaining the same.

I have further to add that following family members are my dependents:

1- Tavisha daughter 6-1/2 yrs

It is therefore, requested that the required "NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE" for obtaing Indian Passport, may kindly be issued with the kind permission of the Hon'ble High Court.
