



(e) That the applicant has at any time during the period of five years immediately preceding the date of his application not being convicted by a court in India from any offence involving moral turpitude and sentenced in respect thereof to imprisonment for not less than two years.

(f) That proceeding in respect of any offence alleged to have not been committed by the applicant are pending before a criminal court in India.

(g) That a warrant or summons for the appearance or warrant for the arrest of the applicant has not been issued by a court under any law for the time being in force or that an order prohibiting the departure from India of the applicant has not been made by any such court.

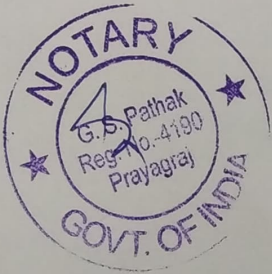
(h) That the applicant has not been repatriated.
