**Subject:** Information to the Hon'ble Court regarding claim of car belonging to the undersigned applicant which met with an accident and information regarding getting a car as gift from elder brother.

Respected Sir,

1. I most humbly beg to submit that I belong to the 2018 batch of Civil Judges (Junior Division). I have joined the Judicial Service on 15.11.2019 and I am currently posted as Judicial Magistrate-III, Ayodhya.
2. Before my coming into Judicial Service, I had purchased a car (Innova Crysta V 2.4 Diesel) from Sunny Toyota, Lucknow. I had taken the said money of consideration to be paid to the seller from my father Shri Suresh Kumar Mishra who was a Bank Officer and my elder brother Shri Gaurav Kumar Mishra who is a Government teacher.
3. I had submitted my first property statement to the Hon'ble Court on 31.08.2020 and had disclosed therein that the said car was purchased by me on 11.09.2019.
4. On 17.07.2022 morning my vehicle bearing number UP-32-KU-8200 met with an accident due to which my vehicle was damaged badly. However, no injury or loss was caused to anyone. At the time of accident my aforesaid vehicle was driven by my driver Mr. Anurag.

5. My vehicle was insured by Policy Number 42080031212000000748 from The New India Assurance Company Ltd. After assessment of loss, the claim has been approved for 'Total Loss' by The Insurance Company.
6. The New India Insurance Company settled the claim by crediting the amount as per policy to my State Bank of India Bank Account No. 30455501370 at Kunda branch. The amount credited by the Company and salvage/wreck value is 21,93,568 INR.
7. As the undersigned was not in possession of any vehicle due to the above mentioned incident. So, on 29.05.2023 elder brother of the undersigned Shri Sandeep Kumar Mishra who is Doctor by profession gifted his own first hand car to me which was purchased by him before entering into my judicial service i.e. in the year 2014 and got Registration Certificate transferred in the name of the undersigned. Copy of RC and insurance of the said gifted vehicle bearing registration no. UP 70 CN 8096 is annexed herewith.

I, therefore, request your goodself to place this application of mine before the Hon'ble Court for its kind perusal.
