RULES

- 1. No candidates shall be eligible for the award of LL.M. Degree unless he/she passed Part I and Part II examination separately. The marks of Part I and Part II examinations shall be added together for the purpose of award of Division.
- 2. No candidate shall be declared to have passed Part I or Part II examination unless he/she has secured 50% marks in aggregate of all the courses subject to securing 40% marks in each course of the concerned part.
- 3. The division shall be determined on the basis of the aggregate of marks of all the courses prescribed for a degree as under:

First Division - 60% or above.

Second Division - 50% or above but below 60%
