

- (c) That the departure of the applicant from India may not, are is not likely to be detrimental to the security of India;
- (d) That the presence of the applicant outside India may, are is not likely to, prejudice the friendly relations of India with any foreign country;
- (e) That the applicant has, at any time during the period of five years immediately preceding the date of his application, not being convicted by a court in India for any offence involving moral turpitude and sentenced in respect of imprisonment for not less than two years;
- (f) That proceeding in respect of any offence alleged to have not been committed by the applicant are pending before a criminal court in India;
- (g) That a warrant of summons for the appearance or a warrant for the arrest of the applicant has not been issued by a court under any law of the time being in force or that an order prohibiting the departure from India of the applicant has not made by any such court;
- (h) That the applicant has not been repatriated;
- (i) That there shall not be any possibility of arising embarrassing position before Government of U.P. due to my visit to any foreign country;
- (j) That the applicant has never been refused for issuance of identity certificate for obtaining a passport;
- (k) That the applicant has never visited any foreign country so far;
