

Subject: Regarding permission for foreign travel to Indonesia

Respected sir,

It is most respectfully and humbly submitted that I got married on 19.01.2024 to Sagar Singh, Additional Civil Judge (J.D.) Hasanpur Amroha. I wish to visit Indonesia during the summer vacation for honeymoon trip from 12.06.2024 to 23.06.2024 (Summer recess from 12.06.2024 to 21.06.2024 and 22nd and 23rd of June are Fourth Saturday and Sunday respectively). The undersigned holds a valid passport bearing number S4206552. The copy of the passport is annexed with the application.

The expenses of the proposed trip shall be borne by me and my husband jointly. my saving account number 000031813100467 has balance of Rs. 13,97,444/- the copy of the passbook is annexed as annexure I. The account of my husband (Sagar Singh, Civil judge (JD) Hasanpur Amroha) bearing number 6314000400003690 has a balance of Rs. 1,51,397/- copy of passbook is annexed as Annexure II. Proposed expense of the said foreign trip is approximately Rs. 1,50,000/- estimated expenditure list is attached as annexure III.

It is further humbly requested that the delay in seeking the permission be condoned as the undersigned had earlier applied within time (2 months prior) for the permission to visit Europe during the same duration, however, the schengen visa formalities are taking time and June being the peak travel season for Europe the undersigned did not get the Visa appointment for the abovesaid dates. Due to it the undersigned kindly requests that the present application be considered in lieu of the previous application.

I, further, undertake the following:

1. My journey is scheduled in summer vacation.
2. I am citizen of Republic of India by birth.
3. I will not do any act in Indonesia which harms the integrity and sovereignty of Republic of India.
4. My foreign travel will not bring insult or shame to Republic of India and State of Uttar Pradesh.
5. My foreign travel will not affect Republic of India's friendly relation with any other country.



6. My foreign travel will not threaten security of Republic of India.
7. There is no Criminal Case pending against me in any Court in Republic India.
8. That by my abroad visit, no dilemma is likely to create before the Government of India or before Government of Uttar Pradesh.
9. That such type of request for abroad visit was not refused to me earlier.
10. That I have never visited any foreign country, before or after my date of joining.

Kindly place this before the Hon'ble Court.

With utmost faith in your authority. I am seeking permission of the Hon'ble Court for foreign travel which is scheduled in summer vacation.
