$$SGPA = \frac{\text{Sum of (Credits X Grade Points) obtained in Concerned Semester}}{\text{Total Credit of Concerned Semester}}$$

$$CGPA = \frac{\text{Total of (Credits X Grade Points) obtained in I and II Semester or I to IV Semester or I to VI Sem. (As the case may be)}}{\text{Summation of credits of Concerned Semester}}$$

NOTE:

The SGPA and CGPA shall be computed up to 2 place of decimals (truncated at the second place)
 The conversion formula for converting CGPA to the corresponding percentage of marks will be as follows:
 $X = 10 Y - 4.5$
 Where, X = Percentage of Marks
 Y = CGPA

Declaration of Division:

A candidate who has passed in all the courses of examinations of I, II, III & IV Semesters taken together will be declared as "Passed" Such passed candidates may be awarded with the division according to the following criterion

- (i) First Division with distinction CGPA 8.5 and above
- (ii) First Division CGPA 6.5 and above but below 8.5
- (iii) Second Division CGPA 5.00 and above but below 6.5

IMPORTANT
