3. Are there any specific requirements or restrictions for online students? – **No, students must maintain an attendance rate of at least 75%. Otherwise, they will not be permitted to sit for the end-term examinations.**
4. How can I access course materials and participate in discussions remotely? – **All course materials for part-time PhD students will be available online. They can access the library using their JGU email ID.**
5. What support services are available for online students? – **All support services are the same for our full-time and part-time scholars, except for the fellowship. The JGU fellowship is offered only to full-time scholars.**
6. Is there an entrance examination required for admission to the PhD program, and if so, what are the details regarding the exam format, dates, and eligibility criteria? – **You will receive a detailed email shortly.**

5. The names of two academic/ non-academic referees from whom the University may seek information on the research potential of the applicant (not from JGU)

6. Brief proposal [about 2500 words] in the following format:

- Brief Overview
- Research Questions
- Review of Literature
- Research Methodology
- Chapter Outline.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

An applicant seeking admission to the Ph.D. Programme must satisfy the following academic criteria set by different Schools/Institutes:

FOR Ph.D. IN LAW

LL.M. with at least 55% marks or an equivalent grade. Applicants with more than 3 years industry/ teaching/ practicing/ managerial/ professional experience will be given preference.

Master's Degree in a discipline relevant to the proposed research with at least 55% marks or equivalent grade having minimum of 3 years managerial/ professional experience.

As a second step, shortlisted students are also required to write a Research Aptitude Test** followed by an interview of students who clear the Research Aptitude Test. All students enrolled in a PhD programme are required to complete the mandatory course work, which broadly includes research methodology, review of literature and suggested specialized courses.

**Further as per the PhD Regulations, the following categories of applicants will be exempted from taking the Entrance Test:

- Applicants who have qualified UGC/ CSIR/ JRF/ NET/ SLET (Haryana State) or any other similar examination.
- Holders of Teacher Fellowships from the UGC or any other Government funding agency.
- Applicants who have completed their Ph.D. coursework/ M.Phil. in another University/ Organization, subject to approval by the SDC.

**The question paper has three parts. Candidate shall attempt all questions in Part I and three questions each from Part II and Part III .

**Answers must be written in clear and comprehensible manner, drawing on relevant literature with citations wherever needed.

**The answer to each questions shall be limited to 600 words only. The theme font of MS Word for written submission shall be Georgia with font size 12 and 1.5 line spacing.

**Plagiarism in all forms will be penalized. Acceptable Plagiarism level will be as per the UGC Policy.
