Regarding additional pay increment in lieu of the degree

of doctorate in law.

Sir,

It is to bring to your kind notice that I had joined the U.P Nyayik Seva in June 2006. As I had already completed my L.LM and was persuing my P.HD, before joining the service, the permission to complete my P.HD from Delhi University was granted by the Hon'ble Court vide letter no. 6224 dated 23.05.2009. The degree of doctorate in law was conferred upon me by University of Delhi upon approval of my thesis in July 2011 which was conferred in the convocation held in March 2012. The said degree of doctorate in law was added in my service record vide O.M No. 1232 dated 13-01-2014, issued by the Government of Uttar Pradesh and letter no. 14994 dated 28- 10 -2013 and letter no. 2829 dated 26-02-14 of the Hon'ble Court.

Consequent to the recommendations of the second SNJPC which had been duly accepted by Hon'ble supreme Court in the case of All India Judges Association versus Union of India vide judgement dated 04-01-24, the government had been please to pass G.O No. 140 dated 28-02-24. With respect to higher qualification allowance it has been mentioned in the aforesaid G.O that one additional advance pay increment shall be awarded to those judicial officers completing the degree of doctorate in law which shall accrue from the date of initial joining if the degree has been obtained before joining the service or if the degree has been obtained after joining the service then from the date of obtaining the said degree.

Sir as the degree of doctorate in law has been awarded to me by the University of Delhi in the year March 2012 ,hence, according to aforereferred provisions, I am also entitled to the benefit of one additional pay increment in respect of the same.

Therefore I humbly request the Hon'ble Court to grant me one additional pay increment in lieu of the degree of doctorate in law, earned by me, from the year 2012. I shall feel obliged.
