A/c, source of which is that Rs. 5,25,000/- is stated to have been transferred to the officer's A/c as gift by his father for the purchase of the aforementioned car & Rs. 1,52,000/- is stated to have been accumulated by him after joining of this service (copy of consent letter of his father along with statement of A/c of the officer can be seen as attachment), Rs. 46,000/- is also stated to have been paid to the Insurance company in cash out of his mother's A/c. The dealer from whom the said car has been purchased by the officer is neither related to him in any way nor any case is pending/decided in his court.

Under the facts & details mentioned above and as the officer has purchased the car from a regular & reputed dealer and has submitted sufficient details about purchase and source of money, if approved, the matter may kindly be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Deepak Verma, Administrative Judge, Rampur also nominated for "Disposal of the matters of the Judicial Officers wherein permission/information for sale or purchase of movable/immovable property and permission/information to accept gift under U.P.
