May kindly see the online application of Sri Punit Mohan Das, Additional Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), Raebareli who joined service on 15.11.2019, drawing gross salary of Rs. 84,388/- & take home salary of Rs. 71,675/- regarding information about purchase of a new Hyundai VERNA car, allotted reg. no. UP63AN6569, intimated through his application dtd. 28.10.2020.

Through his application, Sri Punit Mohan Das has submitted information about purchase of a new car on 15.06.2020 by giving point wise details as per Court's C.L. no. 25/Admin (A) dated 13.07.1998, according to which the car has been purchased by him from M/s Beeaar Hyundai, 9/2, Shahnajaf Rd, Hazratganj, Lucknow who is an authorized dealer, for Rs. 12,30,000/- (copy of invoice can be seen as attachment), source of money of which is the bank loan from UCO Bank, Raebareli of Rs. 10,40,000/- repayable in 84 EMIs of Rs. 16,100/- (Copy of loan arrangement letter can be seen as attachment). Amount of car loan sanctioned Rs. 10,40,000/- is credited to account of the officer concerned on date 15.06.2020 (copy of account statement is attached). Remaining amount of Rs. 1,85,058/- is stated to have been clubbed along with the car loan & Rs. 12,25,058/- is stated to have been paid to the dealer (copy of passbook & statement of A/c can be seen as attachment).

It is also submitted that earlier the matter has been submitted before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Mohd. Faiz Alam Khan, Nominated Judge for the purpose vide office note dated 23.03.2021, but the same has been returned due to change of nomination and it is now likely to be submitted before Hon'ble the Administrative Judge concerned as per the order of nomination passed by Hon'ble The Chief Justice vide order dated 28.10.2021.

Under the facts & details mentioned above and as the officer has purchased the car from a regular & reputed dealer and has submitted sufficient details about purchase and source of money, if approved, the matter may kindly be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Jayant Banerji, Administrative Judge, Raebareli, also nominated for "Disposal of the matters of Judicial Officers wherein permission/information for sale or purchase of movable/ immovable property and permission/ information to accept gift under U.P. Government Servants' Conduct Rules 1956" for the district Raebareli, for His Lordship's kind perusal and information under Rule 24 (2) U.P. Government Servant's Conduct Rules, 1956?
