May kindly see the online application of Sri Aditya Chaturvedi, Judge, Special Court, CBI Lucknow, who, joined service on 21.06.2006, drawing gross salary of Rs. 1,63,189/- & take home salary of Rs. 1,20,007/- regarding information about purchase of Gold ring 18K with Diamond and Golden Tops 20K, intimated through application dated 15.01.2021.

Through his application, Sri Aditya Chaturvedi has submitted information about purchase of Gold weighing 18.37 gm. and Diamond weighing 1.04 cts on 12.11.2020 by giving point wise details as per Court's C.L. no. 25/Admin (A) dated 13.07.1998, according to which the gold item has been purchased by him from Koshda Jewellery House, Tilak Dwar, Mathura (U.P.) who is an authorised dealer, for Rs. 2,47,000/- (copy of invoice can be seen as attachment), source of money of which is that the total sum of the item is stated to have been paid through cheque no. 878185 out of his S.B. A/c no. 11106409445, SBI, Lucknow (copy of passbook can be seen as attachment). The dealer from whom the said item has been purchased by the officer is neither related to him in any way nor any case is pending/decided in his court.

The matter was previously submitted to Hon'ble Mr. Justice Pradeep Kumar Srivastava, Nominated Judge, through detailed office note dated 08.09.2021, placed above, and after retirement of Hon'ble Nominated Judge, the matter has been reverted back. Thereafter, as per order dated 28.10.2021 of Hon'ble The Chief Justice, such matters i.e. work relating to 'Disposal of the matters of the Judicial Officers, wherein permission/ information for sale or purchase of movable/ immovable property and permission/ information to accept gift under U.P. Government Servants' Conduct Rules 1956" is assigned to Hon'ble Administrative Judge of the district concerned, where the concerned Judicial Officer is posted. As such, the matter is now likely to be placed before Hon'ble The Administrative Judge of the district concerned.

Under the facts & details mentioned above and as the officer has purchased the car from a regular & reputed dealer and has submitted sufficient details about purchase and source of money, if approved, the matter may kindly be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Mahesh Chandra Tripathi, Administrative Judge, Lucknow, also nominated for 'Disposal of the matters of the Judicial Officers, wherein permission/ information for sale or purchase of movable/ immovable property and permission/ information to accept gift under U.P. Government Servants' Conduct Rules 1956" for the district Lucknow, for His Lordship's kind perusal and information under Rule 24 (2) U.P. Government Servant's Conduct Rules, 1956?
