## <u>Joint Registrar (J) (Budget)</u>

May kindly see the online application of Sri Yatendra Pal Singh, Civil Judge (Junior Division), Budaun who, joined service on 16.12.2019, drawing gross salary of Rs. 84,188/- & take home salary of Rs. 70,675/- regarding information about purchase of a new Mahindra Bolero car, allotted reg. no. UP81CB5275, intimated through application dated 20.01.2021.

Through his application, Sri Yatendra Pal Singh has submitted information about purchase of a new car on 20.08.2020 by giving point wise details as per Hon'ble Court's C.L. no. 25/Admin (A) dated 13.07.1998, according to which the car has been purchased by him from Vineet Automobiles Pvt. Ltd., Delhi Road, Aligarh who is an authorised dealer, for Rs. 10,02,000/- (copy of invoice can be seen as attachment), source of money of which is that Rs. 8,50,000/- has been taken as loan from SBI, Aligarh, repayable in 84 EMIs of Rs. 13,291/- (copy of loan arrangement letter can be seen as attachment), Rs. 1,23,000/- is stated to have been paid out of his own S.B. A/c no. 39018697286 (copy of passbook can be seen as attachment) and Rs. 29,000/- is stated to have been paid in cash (copy of receipts can be seen as attachment). The dealer from whom the said car has been purchased by the officer is neither related to him in any way nor any case is pending/decided in his court.

The matter was submitted before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Om Prakash-VII, the then Nominated Judge, Budaun vide detailed office note dated 18.08.2021, upon which His Lordship has been pleased to order:-

"Office to report as to whether officer has submitted property statement timely or not."

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer has not submitted any of his property statements till date. Thus, there is a delay in the submission of the same. Thereafter, as per order dated 28.10.2021 of Hon'ble The Chief Justice, such matters i.e. work relating to 'Disposal of the matters of the Judicial Officers, wherein permission/ information for sale or purchase of movable/ immovable property and permission/ information to accept gift under U.P. Government Servants' Conduct Rules 1956" is assigned to Hon'ble Administrative Judge of the district concerned, where the concerned Judicial Officer is posted. As such, the matter is now likely to be placed before Hon'ble The Administrative Judge of the district concerned.

Under the facts & details mentioned above and as the officer has purchased the car from a regular & reputed dealer and has submitted sufficient details about purchase and source of money, if approved, the matter may kindly be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Ajit Kumar, Administrative Judge, Budaun, also nominated for 'Disposal of the matters of the Judicial Officers, wherein permission/ information for sale or purchase of movable/ immovable property and permission/ information to accept gift under U.P. Government Servants' Conduct Rules 1956" for the district Budaun, for His Lordship's kind perusal and information under Rule 24 (2) U.P. Government Servant's Conduct Rules, 1956?
