May kindly see the online application of Sri Rameshwar Dayal, the then Civil Judge (Junior Division), Biswan- Sitapur presently posted as Civil Judge (Senior Division) (Fast Track Court), Meerut, regarding grant of permission for submission of his Ph.D. thesis, on the topic of "Working of Law Enforcement Agencies and Its Socio-Legal Aspects With Special Reference To Police System in Uttar Pradesh" in the supervision of Dr Rajeev Singh Rathi, Department of law, University of Lucknow.

In his application, Sri Dayal has submitted that he has been a research scholar of Lucknow University prior to his joining in U.P. Nyayik Sewa on 13.01.2017 and he got registered on 28.10.2013 in the Ph.D., on the topic of "Working of Law Enforcement Agencies and Its Socio-Legal Aspects With Special Reference To Police System in Uttar Pradesh" in the supervision of Dr Rajeev Singh Rathi. He has also submitted that he had completed his research work before joining of service but he could not submit his thesis due to judicial work of service and now he wants to submit his thesis of Research Work. Thereafter, online objections were raised through the online portal through which, the officer was asked to intimate about the status of thesis submission and about viva-voce.

In reply of the same the officer has stated that he has not submitted his research thesis and stated that he can submit research thesis with in two month after permission of the Hon'ble Court and no schedule has been fixed for viva-vice and it might be scheduled after final submission of the research thesis. Thereafter, through online objection, as asked by Ld. Registrar (J) (Budget), the officer has been asked as to whether extension of time beyond date 30.06.2021 is awarded to him by the concerned University for submission of thesis. In reply the officer has uploaded the copy of letter from the University (can be seen as attachment) wherein it is mentioned that he has been given time-extension for submission of thesis till 31.12.2022. He has also enclosed Ph.D. Course work certificate, permission letter of registrar regarding extension of time for thesis submission and other related papers of Ph.D. program as attachments. He has, therefore, requested to Hon'ble Court to grant him permission for submission of his Ph.D. thesis to University of Lucknow.

In this connection, it is stated that the officer has joined the U.P. Judicial Service on 13.01.2017. There is circular letter dated 4.11.11, which provides that if any Judicial Officer during the course of his Service, requests to pursue higher studies, he has to apply for grant of 'Study Leave' as per rules which will be subject to the discretion of Hon'ble the Chief Justice. In the instant case, as the officer has stated that he has already completed his course work prior to his joining and now only thesis submission is left, it appears that the same is not required. Now, It is on the discretion of the Court either to grant permission to the officer for submission of Ph.D. thesis or to pass any such order which deems to be proper.

May, therefore, if approved, the instant matter may be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Pritinker Diwaker, Senior Judge (J-1) for His Lordship's kind perusal and if His Lordship approves:-

(a) Sri Rameshwar Dayal, presently posted as Civil Judge (Senior Division) (Fast Track Court), Meerut be granted permission for submission of Ph.D. thesis, on the topic "Working of Law Enforcement Agencies and Its Socio-Legal Aspects With Special Reference to Police System in Uttar Pradesh" in the supervision of Dr Rajeev Singh Rathi, Department of Law, University of Lucknow, as requested.

Or

(b) To pass any other order which His Lordship deem fit and proper .
