May kindly see the online requisition dated 06.03.2021 of Sushri Priyamvada Priyadarshini, Addl. Civil Judge (Junior Div.), Deoria, requesting for inclusion of her LL.M. qualification in her service records vide Case Id No. 03482021. In view of the above, Sushri Priyamvada Priyadarshini has furnished her duly attested scanned copies of mark-sheet/gradesheet (both semesters) and LL.M. Degree Qualification as well as prayer for inclusion of LL.M. Qualification in her service records. as supporting documents for the same.

In context of the above, it is submitted that Sushri Priyamvada Priyadarshini, aforesaid, joined U.P. Judicial Services on 16.11.2019 as Addl. Civil Judge (Junior Div.), Deoria. If approved, the matter may be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Rajnish Kumar, Administrative Judge, Deoria, for his lordship's kind perusal and order to the effect that a copy of her online requisition dated 06.03.2021 along with attested copies of mark-sheet/gradesheet and degree of LL.M. as well as attested copy of form of U.P.Nyayik Sewa of Sushri Priyamvada Priyadarshini, Addl. Civil Judge (Junior Div.), Deoria, may be sent to the Joint Secretary, Appointment Section-4, Government of U.P., Lucknow for obtaining necessary orders of the Government of U.P. in the instant matter.
