May kindly see letter dated 14.03.2021 along-with attested copies of mark-sheet (both semesters) and degree of LL.M qualification (**uploaded on 22.03.2021 at SL No. 03 & 04)** of Sri Arjit Verma, Addl. Civil Judge (Junior Div.), Lucknow, requesting for inclusion of LL.M qualification in his service-records.

Sri Arjit Verma, aforesaid, had earlier requested on 14.03.2021 for inclusion of LL.M. Qualification in his service records uploading self attested copies of mark-sheet and Degree of LL.M. Qualification (uploaded on 14.03.2021 at SL No. 01 & 02). Thereafter, he was requested to upload attested copies of mark-sheets (all semesters/years) and Degree of LL.M. Qualification vide online office note dated 16.03.2021. In response, now all relevant documents i.e. mark-sheet and Degree of LL.M. qualification is uploaded on 22.03.2021 (at SL No. 03 & 04) and also prayer for inclusion of LL.M. Qualification in his service-records on 14.03.2021.

In this context, it is submitted that Sri Arjit Verma, aforesaid, joined U.P. Judicial Services on 16.12.2019 as Addl. Civil Judge (Junior Div.), Lucknow. Besides, as apparent from submitted attested copies of mark-sheets and degree of LL.M (uploaded on 22.03.2021 at SL No. 03 & 04), Sri Arjit Verma, completed LL.M. course in year 2019 and was subsequently awarded Degree from Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia National Law University, Lucknow on 10.07.2019. Nevertheless, relevant details about course completion is not mentioned in his application form of U.P. Nyayik Sewa, thus, said qualification is required to be included in his service records.

It is further submitted that appointing authority of Judicial Officers is the Government of U.P., thus qualification of LL.M degree, may be included in the service records of Sri Arjit Verma, aforesaid with the permission of Government of U.P., Lucknow. Therefore, it seems proper that aforesaid letter dated 14.03.2021 of Sri Arjit Verma, Addl. Civil Judge (Junior Div.), Lucknow, may be sent to the Government of U.P. for obtaining necessary orders.

If approved, the matter may be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Surya Prakash Kesarwani, Administrative Judge, Lucknow, for kind perusal and if His Lordship approves for order to the effect that copy of aforesaid letter dated 14.03.2021 along with attested copies of mark-sheets and degree of LL.M. (uploaded on 22.03.2021 at SL No. 03 & 04), as well as attested copy of form of U.P.Nyayik Sewa of Sri Arjit Verma, Addl. Civil Judge (Junior Div.), Lucknow, may be sent to the Joint Secretary, Appointment Section-4, Government of U.P., Lucknow for obtaining necessary orders of the Government of U.P. in instant matter?
