May kindly see the online application of Sri Avnish Saxena, the then Special Officer, Vigilance, High Court, Allahabad presently posted as District & Sessions Judge, Gautam Budh Nagar who, joined service on 16.12.2008, drawing gross salary of Rs. 2,20,108/- & take home salary of Rs. 1,99,338/- regarding information about purchase of a new Innova Crysta 2.4 G car, intimated through application dtd. 05.05.2021 and supplementary details dated 19.05.2021.

Through his application, Sri Avnish Saxena has submitted information about purchase of a new car on 27.04.2021 by giving point wise details as per Court's C.L. no. 25/Admin (A) dated 13.07.1998, according to which the car has been purchased by him from Uttam Toyota, A-11, Meerut Road, Indl. Area, Ghaziabad, U.P. who is an authorised dealer, for Rs. 22,78,667/- (copy of invoice can be seen as attachment), source of money of which Rs. 15,00,000/- has been taken as car loan from HDFC bank repayable in 84 EMIs of Rs. 22,933/- (copy of Loan statement can be seen as attachment), Rs. 5,25,000/- is stated to have been paid out of his own S.B. A/c no. 30620278026 & Rs. 2,68,687/- is stated to have been paid out of his HDFC A/c no. 05961530013565 (copy of statement of SBI salary account statement 2021 and HDFC bank statemnt 2021 respectively can be seen as attachment). The officer has also stated that from the amount obtained from the closure of two SBI life policies and from closure of his PPF account he got sufficient amount, through which he has paid the rest amount required for the purchase of car. The dealer from whom the said car has been purchased by the officer is neither related to him in any way nor any case is pending/decided in his court.

It is pertinent to mention here that earlier the officer was posted as Special Officer, Vigilance, High Court, Allahabad and as per resolution passed in the meeting of the Hon'ble Administrative Committee held on 12.07.2013, he was under the exclusive control of the Hon'ble The Chief Justice and as such the matter was likely to be placed before Hon'ble The Chief Justice but as the posting of the officer has been changed and is now posted as District & Sessions Judge, Gautam Budh Nagar, this matter is submitted to Hon'ble the Administrative Judge concerned.

Under the facts & details mentioned above and as the officer has purchased the car from a regular & reputed dealer and has submitted sufficient details about purchase and source of money, if approved, the matter may kindly be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Rohit Ranjan Agarwal, Administrative Judge, Gautam Budh Nagar also nominated for "Disposal of the matters of the Judicial Officers wherein permission/information for sale or purchase of movable/immovable property and permission/information to accept gift under U.P. Government Servant's Conduct Rules, 1956", for the district Gautam Budh Nagar, for His Lordship's kind perusal and information under Rule 24(2) of U.P. Government Servant's Conduct Rules, 1956?
