May kindly see the online application of Sri Mahesh Nautiyal, Principal Judge, Family Court, Lalitpur who joined service on 16.03.1996, drawing gross salary of Rs. 2,11,653/- & take home salary of Rs. 1,60,653/- regarding information about purchase of a new i20 Sportz Kappa MT car, allotted reg. no. UP80 FW1080, intimated through application dated 06.07.2021.

Through his application, Sri Mahesh Nautiyal has submitted information about purchase of a new car on 28.04.2021 by giving pointwise details as per Court's C.L. no. 25/Admin (A) dated 13.07.1998, according to which the car has been purchased by him from Rajendra Auto wheels Pvt. Ltd., Etawah for Rs. 8,67,500/- in total (copy of invoice can be seen as attachment), source of money of which is that Rs. 6,50,000/- (excluding process fees 3068/-) has been taken as loan from SBI repayable in 84 EMIs of Rs. 10,083/- (copy of 'loan arrangement letter' can be seen as attachment), & Rs. 2,18,000/- is stated to have been adjusted as exchange value of his old Hyundai i-20 Magna car, which has been transferred in his name after the death of his father. The complete information regarding Hyundai i-20 car is placed on the portal on 03.09.2020 vide id. No 983 (copy of 'Exchange Related' paper can be seen as attachment). The dealer from whom the said car has been purchased by the officer is neither related to him in any way nor any case is pending/decided in his court.

Under the facts & details mentioned above and as the officer has purchased the car from a regular & reputed dealer and has submitted sufficient details about purchase and source of money, if approved, the matter may kindly be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Syed Aftab Husain Rizvi, Administrative Judge, Lalitpur, also nominated for 'Disposal of the matters of the Judicial Officers, wherein permission/information for sale or purchase of movable/ immovable property and permission/ information to accept gift under U.P. Government Servants' Conduct Rules 1956" for the district Lalitpur, for His Lordship's kind perusal and information under Rule 24 (2) U.P. Government Servant's Conduct Rules, 1956?
