

### **Registrar (J) (Budget)**

May kindly see the online application of Sri Ravindra Kumar-IV, the then Presiding Officer, MACT, Hardoi, presently posted as Principal Judge, Family Court, Hathras, by which he has submitted supplementary details/ papers in connection with information regarding sale of his old Hyundai i-10 car to a private person in compliance of Court's order.

In this connection, it is submitted that Sri Ravindra Kumar was the owner of an old Hyundai i-10 car bearing reg. no. HR51 AS0270 which has been sold to Sri Ankit Seth S/o Sri Subhash Chandra R/o 1024/63, Ward No.- 12 Jawahar Nagar Camp, Palwal, Haryana (a private person) on 14.03.2022 for Rs. 1,70,000/-. Thus, the officer has been asked by this Court to clarify as to why he has sold his Hyundai i-10 car to a private person namely Sri Ankit Seth S/o Sri Subhash Chandra R/o 1024/63, Ward No.- 12, Jawahar Nagar Camp, Palwal, Haryana without obtaining prior permission of the Court and thus violated the provisions of Rule 24 (2) of U.P. Government Servant's Conduct Rules 1956. The officer has submitted that he had applied for it last year, months earlier, in November 21. Car prices for a 2012 Model, Petrol version, were going down in Car Market, day by day. Only to avoid deficit, he has sold his car to a genuine person for a fair price in March 2022. He had no intention/ propensity to violate Conduct rules as he has always been a Law abiding citizen/Public Servant. The matter was submitted before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Abdul Moin, nominated as Administrative Judge, Hardoi for disposal of the matters. Thus, His Lordship had been pleased to order on 04.02.2023:

***“Perused the report dated 02.02.2023 submitted by the office.***

***Matter pertains to the Car sold by the Judicial Officer without previous sanction of the appropriate authority.***

***Before proceeding further with the matter, it would be appropriate that the officer be required to indicate as to whether the vehicle had been sold through a regular and reputed dealer.***

***Let such information be submitted by the officer concerned within three weeks.”***

The order was communicated online to the officer on 08.02.2023.

In reply of the Court's order, Sri Ravindra Kumar, within the prescribed time of three weeks i.e. on 15.02.2023 has submitted that he had sold his car through a regular and reputed dealer in his Home District-Faridabad, Haryana. However, he has not submitted any supporting papers in support of his submission. It is also pertinent to mention here that the officer was earlier posted as Presiding Officer (MACT), Hardoi hence, the matter was put up before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Abdul Moin, Administrative Judge for the District Hardoi. Now, the posting of the officer has been changed & is now posted as Principal Judge, Family Court Hathras, and as such, the matter is to be laid before the Administrative Judge for the District Hathras relating to the instant matter.

Under the facts & circumstances, may, therefore, if approved, the matter be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Anish Kumar Gupta, Administrative Judge, Hathras for disposal of the matters of Judicial Officers, of information/ permission of sale/ purchase of movable/ immovable property or gift etc., for the District Hathras for His Lordship's kind perusal & further order in the matter of information regarding sale of his old Hyundai i-10 car to a private person by Sri Ravindra Kumar-IV, Principal Judge, Family Court Hathras now?
