May kindly see the online application of Sri Abhishek Singh-III, the then Nyayadhikari, Gram-Nyayalaya, Tundla- Firozabad presently posted as Civil Judge (Junior Division), Ambedkar Nagar at Akbarpur who joined service on 16.12.2019, drawing gross salary of Rs. 84,188/- & take home salary of Rs. 71,675/- regarding information about purchase of a new Maruti Suzuki Vitara Breezza car, allotted reg. no. UP13 BP0829, intimated through application dated 09.12.2021.

Through his application, Sri Abhishek Singh-III has submitted information about purchase of a new car on 13.12.2019 by giving pointwise details as per Hon'ble Court's C.L. no. 25/Admin (A) dated 13.07.1998, according to which the car has been purchased by him from Rohan Motors, Plot Number 561 Bahoor Crossing, Delhi Road, Bulandshahar for Rs. 9,75,000/- (copy of invoice can be seen as attachment), source of money of which is that Rs. 8,50,000/- has been taken as loan from ICICI Bank, Firozabad Branch, Bulandshahar repayable in 60 EMIs of Rs 17,571/- (copy of 'loan arrangement letter' can be seen as attachment) and Rs. 1,00,000/- stated to has been withdrawn from his saving bank account of SBI Bank branch Aurangabad Bulandshahar through cheque no. 962232 and has been deposited in the dealer's account (copy of passbook can be seen as attachment). For the rest amount, the officer has stated that his father has given on amount of Rs. 25000/- on his side directly to Rohan Motors and in this transaction Rohan Motors has not provided any separate receipt except of sale invoice. The officer has also stated that the dealer from whom the said car has been purchased by the officer is neither related to him in any way nor any case is pending/decided in his court.

Under the facts & details mentioned above and as the officer has purchased the new car from a regular & reputed dealer and has submitted sufficient details about purchase and source of money, if approved, the matter may kindly be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Deepak Verma, Administrative Judge, Ambedkar Nagar, also nominated for 'Disposal of the matters of the Judicial Officers, wherein permission/ information for sale or purchase of movable/ immovable property and permission/ information to accept gift under U.P. Government Servants' Conduct Rules 1956" for the district Ambedkar Nagar, for His Lordship's kind perusal and information under Rule 24 (2) U.P. Government Servant's Conduct Rules, 1956?
