May kindly see the online application of Sri Ajay Kumar Tripathi-II, Principal Judge, Family Court, Rampur who joined service on 22.03.2001, drawing gross salary of Rs. 2,14,423/- & take home salary of Rs. 1,66,523/- regarding information about purchase of a new Maruti Suzuki Dzire car, allotted reg. no. UP32 ML5040 (Copy of RC can be seen as attachment namely- Record, page no.7) intimated through application dated 10.01.2022.

Through his application, Sri Ajay Kumar Tripathi-II has submitted information about purchase of a new car on 25.11.2021 by giving pointwise details as per Court's C.L. no. 25/Admin (A) dated 13.07.1998, according to which the car has been purchased by him from KTL Automobile Pvt. Ltd., Raebareli, for Rs. 9,19,405/- in total (Copy of Tax invoice can be seen as attachment namely- Copy of Invoice of purchased car), source of money of which is that Rs. 6,00,000/- has been taken as loan from State Bank of India, Pratapgarh repayable in monthly EMIs of Rs. 20,000/- (copy of 'loan arrangement letter' can be seen as attachment namely- Record, page no. 5-6), Rs. 2,58,000/- is stated to have been paid out of his saving bank account(copy of statement of A/c can be seen as attachment namely- Bank Statement), Rs. 42,000/- is stated to have been paid in exchange of his old car(copy of 'delivery receipt' can be seen as attachment namely- Record, page no. 1), Rs. 11,000/- is stated to have been paid as booking amount (Copy of Receipt can be seen as attachment namely- Record, page no. 2), Rs. 8,500 is stated to be given as a discount. The dealer from whom the said car has been purchased by the officer is neither related to him in any way nor any case is pending/decided in his court.

Under the facts & details mentioned above and as the officer has purchased the car from a regular & reputed dealer and has submitted sufficient details about purchase and source of money, if approved, the matter may kindly be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Subhash Chandra Sharma, Administrative Judge, Rampur also nominated for "Disposal of the matters of the Judicial Officers wherein permission/information for sale or purchase of movable/immovable property and permission/information to accept gift under U.P. Government Servant's Conduct Rules, 1956", for the district Rampur for His Lordship's kind perusal and information under rule 24(2) of U.P. Government Servant's Conduct Rules, 1956?
