May Kindly see the online application of Sri Rohit Puri, Civil Judge (Junior Division), Saharanpur by which he has requested for grant of permission to appear in the Mains examination of Haryana Civil Services (Judicial Branch) Examination-2020-21.

In his application, Sri Rohit Puri has stated that he wishes to participate in the Mains Examination of Subordinate Judicial Services to be conducted by Haryana Public Service Commission (Namely HCS- Judicial Branch Examination, 2021) as he has cleared the Preliminary stage of the above mentioned Examination. He has also stated that he has already been granted permission to appear in the Preliminary Examination by the Hon'ble High Court and the Mains examination is proposed to be held from 15.04.2022 to 17.04.2022 (tentatively). He has also enclosed online approval of Hon'ble Court for prelims and announcement regarding dates of Mains examination, which can be seen as attachments. He has, therefore, requested for grant of permission to appear in the aforesaid examination.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer has joined U.P. Nyayik Sewa on 16.12.2019. Earlier, vide order dated 19.03.2021 of Hon'ble Administrative Judge, Saharanpur, he had been accorded permission to appear in the Preliminary Examination of Haryana Civil Services (Judicial Branch) Examination 2020-2021. Now, it is desirable that he may be accorded permission to appear in the Mains Examination of the same as he has cleared the preliminary examination, if the Hon'ble Court so desires. Permission to appear in such type of written examination may be accorded, but subject to the following conditions:-

1. Government work should not suffer in any way.
2. No preferential treatment will be given in the matter of leave, postings and transfer.
3. The permission can be withdrawn without notice if; it is found at any time that the government servant neglects his normal work or that public work suffers, in any way.

May, therefore, if approved, the instant matter be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Rajiv Gupta, Administrative Judge, Saharanpur for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders to the effect that permission be accorded to Sri Rohit Puri, Civil Judge (Junior Division), Saharanpur to appear in the Mains examination of Haryana Civil Services (Judicial Branch) Examination- 2020-21, as requested, subject to the conditions mentioned above?
