May kindly see the online application of Smt. Anjali Pandey, Civil Judge (Junior Division) (Fast Track Court), Faizabad regarding grant of permission to visit Dubai during summer vacation for tourism purpose alongwith her husband from 02.06.2022 to 06.06.2022.

In her application, Smt. Anjali Pandey has stated that his husband is going to Dubai for some business related work and she wants to accompany her husband in this tour during summer vacation for 5 days 4 night stay from 02.06.2022 to 06.06.2022 and the expenses of tour approximately is Rs. 2,00,000, which would be borne by her husband. Thereafter through online objections, the officer was asked to intimate about the expenditure, relating papers of source amount and also be asked to submit declarations regarding her abroad visit. In reply the officer has submitted following details:-

1. There will be no such possibility of arising any dilemma before Government of India or U.P. due to her foreign visit to Dubai.

2. She has applied for foreign visit and the application was approved but because her child was 3 month old only therefore she was unable to visit the same. She has also submitted the details of that application, which can be seen as attachment.

3. There will be no such things due to her visit to abroad to U.P. Government a she is visiting with family i.e. her husband and her child and for her husband's tour .

4. Expense of visit would be born by her husband. She has also attached his account statement and index page which is internet packing generated as his bank does not provide passbook.

5. She has never visited before any foreign country and this would be her first visit,.

6. She has attached her passport also.

She has, therefore requested for grant of permission to visit Dubai alongwith her husband in summer vacation for tourism purpose from 02.06.2022 to 06.06.2022.

In this connection, it is submitted that grant of permission to visit abroad is considered in accordance to the G.O.1/3/98-Ka-Prasko/1999 dated 14 June 1999 and in accordance with Hon'ble High Court's Circular Letter No. 16/ IV-f-101/ Admin (A)/ dated 27.05.2017. As per reports, no vigilance/ departmental enquiry is pending against Smt. Anjali Pandey. As per the point no. (1) of Hon'ble High Court's Circular Letter No. 16/ IV-f-101/ Admin (A)/ dated 27.05.2017, Abroad tour by any officer shall not be availed of during working days of the Hon'ble Court or during the period of suspension/departmental proceedings, except in case of medical treatment of himself/ herself, spouse or dependent, or in special circumstances, and tours which are sponsored and/ or approved by the State/ Central Government during certain fixed span of time and does not fall during vacation. In these eventualities the Judicial officers shall seek permission before applying for VISA. Now, in the instant case the officer is going to visit Dubai alongwith her husband and child in summer vacation for tourism purpose from 02.06.2022 to 06.06.2022, this trip appears to be a pleasure trip which falls during summer vacation, It is on the discretion of the Hon'ble High Court either to grant her permission or to pass any such order which deems to be proper. In this connection it is also submitted that in the Hon'ble High Court's Circular Letter dated 27.05.2017, it has been settled that for the purpose of grant of such permission the competent authority for the judicial officers is Hon'ble the Administrative Judge of the District concerned, for the Judicial officers posted in judgeship or on the District of any deputation post, subject to approval by Hon'ble the Chief Justice or any member of the Administrative Committee authorised by the Hon'ble the Chief Justice. Vide subsequent order dated 19.10.2020, Hon'ble the Chief Justice has been pleased to nominate Hon'ble Mr. Justice Pritinker Diwaker, to consider request of permission of the Judicial Officers to visit abroad in his place.

May, therefore, if approved, the instant matter may be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Rahul Chaturvedi, Administrative Judge, Faizabad for kind perusal and if His Lordship approves, Smt. Anjali Pandey, Civil Judge (Junior Division) (Fast Track Court), Faizabad may be granted permission to visit Dubai during summer vacation from 02.06.2022 to 06.06.2022 for tourism purpose alongwith her husband and child, as requested, subject to approval by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Pritinker Diwaker, Nominated Judge, as per Hon'ble High Court's Circular Letter No. 16/ IV-f-101/ Admin (A)/ dated 27.05.2017 and order dated 19.10.2020 of Hon'ble the Chief Justice, as mentioned above with the condition that proper charge of Government records or cash, if any, or any government property with her, may be handed over by her before proceeding abroad?

Or

To pass any other order, which His Lordship deems fit and proper.
