Through his application, Sri Ranjeet Kumar Verma has submitted information about purchase of a new car, purchased on 20.11.2017; by giving pointwise details as per Hon'ble Court's C.L. no. 25/Admin (A) dated 13.07.1998, according to which the car has been purchased by him from a regular & reputed dealer namely AKC Auto Pvt. Ltd., Shahjahanpur, during his posting at Shahjanapur, for Rs. 3,77,131/- (copy of Invoice can be seen as attachment).
