May kindly see the online requisition dated 31.05.2022 vide Case Id No. S00021642022 of Sri Aishwarya Pratap Singh, Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate (Railways), Aligarh, requesting for inclusion of his LL.M. qualification in his service records and for of grant three advance increments.

In his application, Sri Aishwarya Pratap Singh has stated that he has successfully completed LLM from Kurukshetra University after seeking permission from the Hon'ble High Court. He has requested that the degree be kept on record of the applicant and the Hon'ble Court be pleased to grant three advance increments as per G.O. 1363/II-4-2009-45 (12)/91TC dated 13.05.2009. He has also furnished his LL.M. credentials comprising Mark-sheets of previous and final year as well as copy of Degree (**refer attachment dated 20.07.2022 under heading "Attested Mark-sheets & final degree"**) for inclusion of his qualifications in his service records.

In this connection, it is submitted that Sri Aishwarya Pratap Singh, aforesaid joined the U.P. Judicial Service on 31.01.2015, as Additional Civil Judge (Junior Division), Lucknow. Besides, as evident from submitted attested copies of both the years Mark-sheets and Degree of LL.M., Sri Aishwarya Pratap Singh completed two years LL.M. course, in the academic session 2020-21, and was subsequently awarded Degree from Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra in May, 2021 for the Session 2020, thus said qualification may be included in his service-records.

Besides, it is submitted that with respect to said course, Sri Aishwarya Pratap Singh was granted permission to pursue LL.M course, through Distance Learning Programme of Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, starting from the academic session 2018-19, from Hon'ble Court vide Court's letter dated 24.11.2018 (**refer attachment under heading "Permission by Hon'ble Court"**). It is also to be submitted that his second part of prayer i.e. grant three advance increments as per G.O. 1363/II-4-2009-45 (12)/91TC dated 13.05.2009 will be taken up afterward when his qualification of LL.M. is included in his service records by issuance of formal order of the Government.

It is further submitted that appointing authority of Judicial Officers is the Government of U.P., thus qualification of LL.M. Degree may be included in the service records of Sri Aishwarya Pratap Singh, aforesaid with the permission of Government of U.P., Lucknow. Therefore, it seems proper that aforesaid online requisition dated 31.05.2022 of Sri Aishwarya Pratap Singh, Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate (Railways), Aligarh, may be sent to the Government of U.P. for obtaining necessary orders.

Under the facts and details mentioned above, if approved, the matter may kindly be placed before the Hon'ble Mr. Justice Vivek Chaudhary, Administrative Judge, Aligarh, for His Lordship's kind perusal and order to the effect that a copy of his online requisition along with copy of Mark-sheets (previous & final year) and Degree of LL.M. as well as attested copy of form of U.P. Nyayik Sewa of Sri Aishwarya Pratap Singh, Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate (Railways), Aligarh, may be sent to the Joint Secretary, Appointment Section - 4, Government of U.P., Lucknow for obtaining necessary orders of the Government of U.P. regarding inclusion of his LL.M. qualification in his service records ?
