May Kindly see the online application of Sri Mohit Kumar Prasad, Civil Judge (Junior Division), Utraula-Balrampur by which he has requested for grant of permission to appear in the Civil Services preliminary examination 2022, conducted by UPSC.

In his application, Sri Mohit Kumar Prasad has stated that he wants to appear for Civil Service Preliminary Examination 2022, scheduled to be held on 5.6.2022 but the same application was received through e-portal after the date of the said examination, thereafter, the officer was asked to intimate about his appearance in the said preliminary examination. In reply, the officer has stated that he has appeared in the stated examination. He has, therefore, requested for grant of permission to appear in the aforesaid examination.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer has joined U.P. Nyayik Sewa on 01.10.2018. It is pertinent to mention here that as stated by the officer that he has already appeared in Union Public Service Commission Civil Services preliminary examination 2022 in anticipation of the Hon'ble Court's permission. As per facts & circumstances, it appears that in order to regularize the matter it appears that he may be granted ex-post facto permission to appear in the stated preliminary examination, However acceptance of his request is only on the discretion of Hon'ble Court.

May, therefore, if approved, the instant matter be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Dinesh Pathak, Administrative Judge, Balrampur for His Lordship's kind perusal, and if His Lordship approves Sri Mohit Kumar Prasad, Civil Judge (Junior Division), Utraula-Balrampur be granted ex-post facto permission to appear in the preliminary Examination of Civil Services examination 2022 conducted by Union Public Services Commission, as requested?
