May kindly see the online application of Sri Maninder Pal Singh, Civil Judge (Senior Division), Etah regarding grant of permission to get transferred arm & license in his name from his father's name.

In the letters, Sri Maninder Pal Singh has stated that his father was the owner of one firearm's licence no. 1516/GS, Distt. Budaun NPB Revolver no. 5928 (S-H). His father (Late Vijendra Pal Singh) has died on 12.04.2021 due to Covid-19. He has, therefore, requested the Court to grant him permission to get transferred arm & license in his name from his father's name.

In this connection, it is submitted that the relevant rule relating to transfer of movable property Rule-24 (2) of U.P. Government Servant's conduct (Amendment) Rule-1998] runs as under: -

"A Government servant who enters into any transaction concerning any movable property exceeding in value, the amount of his basic pay for one month, whether by way of purchase, sale or otherwise, shall forthwith report such transaction to the appropriate authority; Provided that no Government servant shall inter into any such transaction except with or through a reputed dealer or agent of standing, or with the previous sanction of the appropriate authority."

It is further submitted that the officer has also enclosed copy of death certificate & copy of licence of his father along with his copy of licence which can be seen as attachment. Now, as the officer has requested for grant of permission to get transferred NPB Revolver, in his name from his father's name, he may be granted the permission, as requested, as per the rule referred to above, if the Court deemed fit and proper.

May, therefore, if approved, the matter be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Mohd. Faiz Alam Khan, Administrative Judge, Etah, also nominated for "Disposal of the matters of the Judicial Officers wherein permission/information for sale or purchase of movable/immovable property and permission/information to accept gift under U.P. Government Servants' Conduct Rules 1956" for the district Etah, for His Lordship's kind perusal and if His Lordship approves, Maninder Pal Singh, Civil Judge (Senior Division), Etah be granted permission to get transferred NPB Revolver no. 5928 (S-H) in his name from his father's name, as requested, with the direction that he may furnish copies of the relevant papers of transaction after its completion?
