May Kindly see the online application of Smt. Vandana, Civil Judge (Junior Division), Vidhuna-Auraiya by which she has requested for grant of permission appear in examination for the post of Junior Court Assistant in Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi.

In her application, Smt. Vandana has stated that she is interested in applying and appearing for the examination for the post of Junior Court Assistant (Group 'B' Non-Gazetted) placed in Level 6 of Pay Matrix with initial Basic Pay of Rs. 35,400/- as the Hon'ble Supreme Court has invited online applications for 210 vacancies vide Advertisement No. F.6/2022-SC (RC) New Delhi dated 18.06.2022. The approximate Gross Salary as per existing rate of allowances including HRA comes to Rs. 63068/- per month (per-revised pay scale PB-2 with Grade Pay of Rs. 4200/-) in Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. Thereafter, through online objections, the officer was asked about the date and stage of the stated examination and in reply the officer has stated that the objective (MCQ) test, written test and computer typing test (English) would be done on the same day and the date of the examination has not been notified yet by Hon'ble Supreme Court. She has also enclosed the copy of Advertisement and application form of the stated examination, which can be seen as attachments. She has, therefore, requested to Hon'ble Court to grant her permission to appear in the aforesaid examination.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer has joined the U.P. Nyayik Sewa on 04.07.2018. It is desirable that she may be accorded permission to appear in the written examination for the post of Junior Court Assistant in Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi, at present, if the Hon'ble Court so desires. Permission to appear in such type of written examination may be accorded, but subject to the following conditions:-

1. Government work should not suffer in any way.

2. No preferential treatment will be given in the matter of leave, postings and transfer.

3. The permission can be withdrawn without notice if; it is found at any time that the government servant neglects her normal work or that public work suffers, in any way.

May, therefore, if approved, the instant matter be laid before Hon'ble Mrs. Justice Sadhna Rani (Thakur), Administrative Judge, Auraiya for Her Lordship's kind perusal and orders to the effect that permission be accorded to Smt. Vandana, Civil Judge (Junior Division), Vidhuna-Auraiya to appear in the written examination for the post of Junior Court Assistant in Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi, as requested, subject to the conditions mentioned above?
