<u>Registrar (J) (Budget)</u>

May kindly see the online application of Sri Prashant Bilgaiyan, Registrar (J) (Criminal), High Court, Allahabad who joined service on 12.05.2009, drawing gross salary of Rs. 1,96,541/- & take home salary of Rs. 1,50,398/- regarding information about purchase of a new Maruti Ignis Sigma (Base) Model car, allotted reg. no. UP 32MY 3747, intimated through application dated 27.08.2022 in exchange of his old Alto car.

Through his application, Sri Prashant Bilgaiyan has submitted information about purchase of a new car on 12.07.2022 by giving pointwise details as per Court's C.L. no. 25/Admin (A) dated 13.07.1998, according to which the car has been purchased by him from Bright 4 Wheel Sales Pvt. Ltd., 11/CP6, Vikas Nagar, Ring Road, Lucknow, U.P. for Rs. 5,35,000/- (copy of invoice can be seen as attachment), source of money of which is that Rs. 4,80,000/- is stated to have been paid out of his own S.B. A/c (copy of statement of A/c can be seen as attachment) & rest of the amount is stated to have been adjusted in exchange of his old Alto car (copy of 'Exchange Related Paper' can be seen as attachment). The dealer from whom the said car has been purchased by the officer is neither related to him in any way nor any case is pending/decided in his court.

It is also noteworthy to mention here that normally such type of matters are submitted to Hon'ble the Administrative Judges concerned but as the officer is posted in this Hon'ble Court as Registrar (J) (Criminal) as per resolution passed in the meeting of the Hon'ble Administrative Committee held on 12.07.2013, he is under the exclusive control of the Hon'ble The Chief Justice. As such the matter is likely to be placed before Hon'ble The Chief Justice.

Under the facts & details mentioned above and as the officer has purchased the car from a regular & reputed dealer and has submitted sufficient details about purchase and source of money, if approved, the matter may kindly be laid before Hon'ble The Chief Justice for His Lordship's kind perusal and information under Rule 24 (2) of U.P. Government Servant's Conduct Rules, 1956?
