May kindly see the online requisition dated 16.09.2022 of Sri Raj Kumar Singh, District & Sessions Judge, Hardoi, requesting for inclusion of his LL.M. qualification in his service records vide Case Id No. 24502022. In compliance of same, Sri Raj Kumar Singh furnished his unattested copies of LL.M. Marksheets (Two-years) and attested copy of Degree for inclusion of his qualifications in his service records. Thereafter, an objection, dated 16.09.2022, was raised by the office asking him to submit the attested copies of Mark-sheets of both the years. The said objection was cleared by Sri Raj Kumar Singh by furnishing the desired documents, dated 20.09.2022, required for inclusion of qualification in service records.

In this connection, it is submitted that Sri Raj Kumar Singh, joined the U.P. Judicial Service on 17.01.2011, initially as Additional District & Sessions Judge, Lucknow. Here, it is relevant to mention here that Sri Raj Kumar Singh pursued his LL.M. course from Distance Learning Education from Kurukshetra University after duly taking permission from the office of the High Court vide Court's letter no. 18022/IV-3930/Admin A-4 dated 09.12.2019. Besides, as evident from submitted attested copies of LL.M mark-sheets (both the years) and copy of Degree, Sri Raj Kumar Singh, completed two-years LL.M. degree course in the year 2021 and was subsequently awarded Degree from Kurukshetra University, Haryana on 31.08.2022, thus said qualification may be included in his service records.

It is further submitted that appointing authority of Judicial Officers is the Government of U.P., thus qualification of LL.M. Degree may be included in the service records of Sri Raj Kumar Singh, aforesaid with the permission of Government of U.P., Lucknow. Therefore, it seems proper that aforesaid requisition dated 16.09.2022 of Sri Raj Kumar Singh, District & Sessions Judge, Hardoi, may be sent to the Government of U.P. for obtaining necessary orders.

If approved, the matter may kindly be placed before the Hon'ble Mr. Justice Abdul Moin, Administrative Judge, Hardoi, for kind perusal and order to the effect that copy of Mark-sheets (both the years) and Degree of LL.M as well as attested copy of form of U.P. Nyayik Sewa of Sri Raj Kumar Singh, District & Sessions Judge, Hardoi, may be sent to the Joint Secretary, Appointment Section – 4, Government of U.P., Lucknow for obtaining necessary orders of the Government of U.P. in instant matter?
